Karel is a Ph.D. graduate in the field of “Mathematical Finance” of the prestigious Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh. He graduated from the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of Charles University in Prague in the field of Probability and Mathematical Statistics.
