Winter school "Cultural Diversity and Income Inequality" will be held near Ekaterinburg (Russia) from 15 till 19 December, 2016.

The organizer of the winter school is the NES Center for the Study of Diversity and Social Interactions with support of the Ural Federal University.

Academic director of the school is Professor Shlomo Weber (New Economic School, Southern Methodist University).

Dr. Denis Davydov, NES CSDSI research fellow, is among the experts.

The guest speakers of the school are <u>Erdenebat Bataa</u> (National University of Mongolia and Korea University), <u>Lawrence E. Blume</u> (Cornell University), <u>Steven N. Durlauf</u> (University of Wisconsin-Madison), <u>Jean-Philippe Platteau</u> (Université de Namur) and <u>Hans Wiesmeth</u> (Sächsischen Akademie der Wissenschaften).

Winter school 2016 will be focused on current developments in research on inequality and cultural diversity. Half of the working time will be devoted to the presentations of the research projects by the participants.

The language of the winter school is English.

20–25 invited participants will be informed before November 30, 2016. The paper of the invited participant is expected not later than December 7, 2016.

The organizers will cover the tuition fees, accommodation and meals during the school for invited participants. A limited number of grants (10–15 spots) covering travel expenses might be offered to applicants from the Russian universities on the competitive basis. Participants are responsible for all non-covered costs.
