

NES CSDSI WORKSHOP “NETWORKS AND SOCIAL INTERACTIONS”

The 2nd NES CSDSI workshop for students and young researchers will be held at the NES Campus in Skolkovo (Moscow) from **15 till 19 November, 2016**.

The main goal of the workshop is to introduce students to network theory and applications. Networks are fashionable and rapidly advancing interdisciplinary methodologies with many applications in Economics, Finance, Sociology, Computer Science and other fields. We also aim to foster links between young researchers with different interests in the broad area of network analysis.

At the workshop, we will have tutorials, lectures of invited speakers (both from academia and corporate sector), research presentations, and discussions.

Presentations will be in English and Russian.

This workshop is organized by the *NES Center for the Study of Diversity and Social Interactions* under the project of the RF Government grant No.14.U04.31.0002.
