## **Course description**

The goal of this course is to help students to improve the presentation skills of research papers.

## Course requirements, grading, and attendance policies

The main goal of the seminar meetings is to get a grasp of research question examined by a student. Students should get a clear idea on feasibility of results they are trying to obtain.
