Financial Modeling for Venture Capital, Mergers and Acquisitions

Module 4, Academic Year 2019-2020

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Course description

The course is dedicated to develop decision-making skills regarding investments into both public companies and alternative assets (real estate, private equity, venture companies).

The topics of the course will cover market analysis and research frameworks, the most common investments strategies (LBO, M&A, venture capital, etc.), various techniques of evaluating and comparing projects, as well as examine the choice of sources of financing deals and transactions and their impact on the investors and shareholders' wealth.

Course requirements, grading, and attendance policies

The course is structured as a case-based one. Note that no formal attendance policy is applied to the course, however, the attendance of each class is expected.

Prerequisites. No past course attendance is essential, however, familiarity with corporate finance concepts, financial modeling, financial products and basic accounting skills is desired.

Grading. The grade for the course will be based on two group cases (15% total), three individual assignments (15% total) and project-based final exam (70%). In-class participation and assignments are subject to bonus for the final grade.

Note that in order to pass the course you must get at least 40% of the total score.
